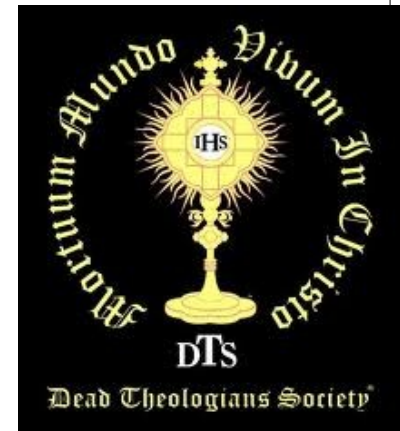

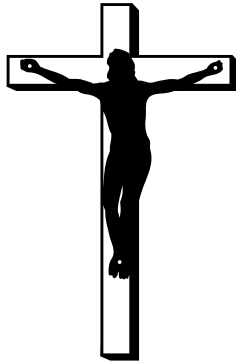

WHAT IS D.T.S.?

The group is especially devoted to learning about the saints, growing in personal holiness and virtue, and praying for the dead. Each meeting will include a presentation on the life of a saint with a discussion of that life to follow.

A modest dinner will be provided for free at all meetings.



D.T.S. GUARDIANS:
